This project consists of the replacement of five cross road culverts and 23 driveway culverts. Road closures will be posted on this site the day before they are planned for replacement. Current projection (weather permitting) is to have all cross road culverts installed by September 5, 2017 and then move to replacing driveway culverts. This maintenance is being taken ahead of the scheduled repaving of Rich Road during the 2018 construction year.
