

ORDINANCE - ~~2007-15~~

Whereas, the DeKalb County Executive Committee has considered a proposed addition to the Rules of Order under which sessions of the DeKalb County Board are conducted, and

Whereas, it was the opinion of the Executive Committee that the rule addition provides for continuing decorum and safety for members of the DeKalb County Board and citizens in attendance at sessions of the Board, and

Whereas, it was the recommendation of the Executive Committee that the new section (14) set forth below be added to the Rules of Order of the DeKalb County Board as set forth in the DeKalb County Code Chapter 2, Article II, Division 2, Section 2-31.

(14) No unauthorized person or persons may enter into or remain in the seating area for the County Board or those areas immediately adjacent to the seating area of the County Board beginning one half hour prior to County Board meetings and ending one half hour after adjournment of the DeKalb County Board. No unauthorized person or persons may distribute materials or speak to members of the County Board in the board seating area during such periods.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED that the DeKalb County Board does concur in the recommendation of the Executive Committee and does hereby adopt the aforesated addition to the Rules of Order and declare violations of said rule to be violations of the DeKalb County Code punishable by fines of up to \$500.00 for each violation.
