Re: Appointment of Election Judges and Leading Political Party

According to the Illinois State Statutes (10ILCS 5/13) the County Board shall select and approve the proper ratio of persons to serve as election judges in each precinct from the certified lists which have been filed with the County Clerk.

"Leading political party" means one of the two political parties whose candidates for governor at the most recent three gubernatorial elections received either the highest or second highest average number of votes. The political party whose candidates for governor received the highest average number of votes shall be known a the first leading political party and the political party whose candidates for governor received the second highest average number of votes shall be known as the second leading political party.

The ratio had not been re-configured since the 2010 cycle and upon examination it was determined that the ratios needed to be re-evaluated and corrected. Attached is a spreadsheet containing the new configuration and will be valid for the next two years, the current Election Judge cycle.



OLD BUSINESS / NEW BUSINESS

Mrs. Haji-Sheikh shared The DeKalb County Forest Preserve, KishHealth System, the Kishwaukee Family YMCA, Live Healthy DeKalb, the Illinois League of Cyclists, and the DeKalb County Convention and Visitor's Bureau will participate in a new program "PEDAL PAL" which was launched last Friday. She explained that PEDAL PAL is a way for local businesses, park districts, forest preserves, municipalities and others in DeKalb County to promote cycling by placing a decal on their establishment which signifies that they are bicycle friendly. Each location that displays the decal agrees to allow passing cyclists to come in and get a drink of water, use the bathroom and/or use the phone in case of emergency. Businesses that display the PEDALPAL decal will be included on the PEDALPAL.org website as locations that are bicycle friendly.

Mrs. Haji-Sheikh also shared that she will be bringing the Bike Friendly Agenda and recently passed resolution to the Regional Planning Commission Meeting on the 29th to help build on to the bike calendar.

Ms. Fauci announced that she would like to revisit an old problem that the Forest Preserve Districts have dealt with and that is a problem with visitors not leashing their dogs. Ms. Fauci indicated that there have been a numerous number of complaints regarding dogs especially in Afton Forest Preserve.

Mr. Hannan handed out a press release regarding leashing dogs in the County's Forest Preserves which stated:

Leashing your dog while in preserves protects your pet, other trail users and our wildlife. By limiting your dog's leeway you'll keep them from harm. Off leash dogs are easily distracted and could chase people, and wildlife, run into traffic, into poison ivy or tick infested brush.

Wildlife that fall prey to dogs are removed from the food chain, which means less food for wildlife. Even without direct contact, a dog's scent causes defensive reactions in wildlife. This drains the wild animal's energy, putting it at risk for malnutrition and predation.

Most of all, leashing your dog demonstrates respect for other preserve visitors. Many people do not welcome advances by unfamiliar dogs. You may know your dog is friendly but others don't.

Ms. Fauci reminded patrons that having dogs in Forest Preserves are a privilege and they have had to revoke other privileges in the past due to non-compliance.

Mr. Hannan and DeKalb County Animal Control Warden, Dan Berres was present to speak on the dog issues in the Forest Preserves.
