

## November Maintenance and Natural Resource Management work report from Josh Clark

Continued working on the shop at Afton. Organized and cleaned. New shelves and storage make it easy to stay organized and find tools and supplies as needed. In 2016 we will add windows and pull down stairs for attic as well as painting of walls and ceiling.

Several successful prescribed fires at Afton. New foam spray fire contol unit was a great addition to prescribed fire tools.

Continued to collect seed from all of the preserves throughout the district. Al tells me that we collected more than last year. We will be able to collect quite a bit more next year with two restoration assistants. Also processed and weighed seed. Processing is a bit slow due to the methods used (hand cleaning, stomping, and the old chipper) but we make do and get it done. The rebuilt machine shed at Afton worked very well for a seed storage location.

Cleaned the chimney stove pipes at Shabbona Preserve. We will be replacing some pipes in December.

Began clearing brush to the east on the rebuilt machine shed at Afton. Idea is to use this area as a propagation/nursery area for native plants in the future to take the place of the areas that were used for this purpose at Al's.
