Mr. Kerner currently leases the property to Myles Tree Service, a tree service and firewood sales business. However, the property is zoned A-1, Agricultural District, and a tree service is a Special Use in that District. In order for the business to continue on the property, a Special Use Permit must be granted by the DeKalb County Board. Before the Board can grant a Special Use Permit, a public hearing must be held before the DeKalb County Hearing Officer.

Mr. Kerner is requesting approval of such a Special Use Permit for a tree service and firewood sales business at 9954 State Route 23, Waterman.
