Unfinished business, they will be breaking ground soon on the new building and it should be done by September 2008. The VAC handbook will be printed soon. The new hire is still under discussion but probably in six months.

New business, we had some discussion on a van for DCVAC and a wheelchair lift for the van will run approximately \$6000. We are currently paying Kendall County VAC to take some of our yets to Hines.
