MARCH 10, 2008

The meeting started at 7:09 with Vice –President Mike Boorsma calling the meeting to order. We had 15 members in attendance and 1 guest. This was seconded by Rich Joslin and the motion passed.

John Davis made the motion to pay the bills for a total of \$7843.30, and this was seconded by Steven Scoughton. The bills were paid.
