Frank Beierlotzer handed out a paper telling about the next Mayor's Breakfast. It will be at Carl's Fargo Restaurant on Monday May 30 from 6:45 A.M. to 7:30 A.M

Mike Boorsma made the motion to pay the commissions bills, totaling \$10389.73 and this was seconded by Don Jones. The bills will be paid. The doll house is still on hold. Our next Vet Fair will be in November at NIU. February 17, Jack Berg of the McCormack Foundation will be coming to our commission to discuss ways to help our veterans. The Chicago Medical Innovation group has been working on a cure for PTSD. Steve Scoughton will be going to learn more about the process which entails getting two shots in the neck. There is much work to be done and trials are only beginning.

At 7:37 Don Jones made the motion to adjourn and this was seconded by Jim Cox. We were adjourned.
