- Fire Radio Reports
  - Johnson reported on behalf of Feyerherm that the Paw Paw fire district radio issues have slowed down. They have decided to delay any work until spring.
- Mapping Software-
  - G. Johnson Reported: County PSAP is very close to going live. Santos with IMO needed to work the data received from LaSalle County to make the data match up to the DeKalb map data. Sandwich and NIU will be implanted after they go live with the mapping.

### **NEW BUSINESS**

- o Member Reappointments due for approval for 2014-
  - A motion was made to re-elect all officers by Hicks and seconded by VanLanduyt. Roll call vote was taken: Chairman King- Y, Hanson- Y, Hicks- Y, Leverton- Y, Lowery- Y, Merritt- Y, Phillips-Y, and VanLanduyt- Y. Motion passed.

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### o January 14, 2014 MABAS Call

Hanson explained his request for lessons learned from the call dealing with the PSAP dispatch. There were no dispatch issues. Students and teachers were transported to the hospital by ambulance. Phillips reported that he had received call from news stations in Chicago asking details.

### Ogle County Back up for 911 calls

G. Johnson stated that the request is still on hold at this time.

### NG911 Consultant RFP

Johnson reported that the RFP was released as planned on January 6, 2014. She then covered all items that have transpired since the RFP was released. RFP's are due in on February 28, 2014. All public notices were posted in local papers and on County websites.

### o ETSB SOP

 Johnson covered the new document. The ETSB will review the document and approved at the March Meeting.

### o Texting 911

Johnson reported that she is still on bi-weekly calls. There is a document close to being ready to release from NENA. She also covered some of the issues that New York is experiencing with the texting process. There is a meeting scheduled March 7, 2014 that would be board member, dispatchers or basically any one working with a PSAP.

### Legislation

- Johnson stated the 9-1-1 advisory Board has met 3 times. She did not drive to the last meeting because of weather. She had gathered the data for DeKalb County as far as full expenses to run a PSAP. The document that was used will be modified and the representatives will fill in their detail on expenses. Johnson stated that a item in the FCC report surfaced and was discussed at the next meeting. The ICC will explain the report that they provided to the FCC.
- Johnson stated that Poison Control has filed legislation to have a portion of the wireless carrier fund issued to them. The INENA and APCO Legislative Committee will try to address that before the votes are made by the Senate and the House of Representatives. Most likely the INENA/APCO Legislation Committee with introduce some type of legislation in 2014.

  - Johnson will be going to Washington DC to meet with legislators in March and all expenses will be paid for by INENA.

- Johnson stated that she still has not received the letter from Frontier on the backup plan for the ECS1000.
- Meeting was held to discuss the DeKalb City PSAP Move- Johnson said they listened to what we had to say.
- o Billing errors on the 911 bill this month. Frontier is investigating
- New Frontier surcharge on the bills
- Malta Fire Department- They had asked about the status of improving the radio coverage for them. Johnson explained to the Malta Chief that at this time there will be no additions to the current radio equipment. Johnson will go back to him and request that he needs to report radio issues to the County PSAP and to Johnson in the future because the County PSAP was not aware of radio issues for them.
