• 2013 Audit:

 Christine handed out the Financial Statements and Independent Auditor's Report and the Auditor's Communication to the Emergency Telephone System Board. She thanked Glenna for all her assistance during the process, and recognized Chris Hansen in her office who worked with auditors.

All funds are balanced, and the Board's investments over and above the FDIC-insured amount of \$250,000, were all fully protected by collateral pledged to us by local banks.

- o There were several Items of note:
 - The Board's net position (formerly net assets) exceeded its liabilities by \$2,172,142. This was \$67,000 less than the previous year due to the loss of hard and wireless lines fees.

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- Of that total, the Board has unrestricted funds of \$1,517,909. Of that number, \$903,604 was assigned for capital outlay which is the amount that the Board has dedicated to the upcoming implementation of the Next Gen 911 system.
- The board has no outstanding debt.
- The unassigned fund balance in the General Fund, as a percentage of General Fund expenditures, is high indicating good financial health.
- We had one auditor comment regarding the posting of prior year audit adjustments, which was addressed while they were still on-site.
- Christine encouraged the Board to read the Management Discussion and Analysis. It discusses the Board's financial position, what factors affected last year, and what economic factors we anticipate will affect the Board this coming year. Those factors include legislation recently passed, investment income, and the implementation of Next Generation 911.
- Closed Meeting Minutes from December 2013- A motion was made to approve the closed session minutes from December 2013 by Lowery and seconded by Merritt. Motion Passes.

OLD BUSINESS

Fire Radio Reports

- Feyerherm reported
 - o No major issues.
 - Feyerherm did visit all microwave sites and three sites need UPS batteries replaced. He will order and install. He still needs to visit three of the PSAPs and that will be done next week.
 - He also reported that there are three locations that internet providers have installed equipment at. He has contact names for the providers and will watch to see if there is any interference with our infrastructure in the future.

Mapping Software-

G. Johnson Reported: County PSAP is live with the new map software. There were some minor issues. They have been working through them as they surface. The microDATA software will stay working until Sandwich Police PSAP and Northern Illinois University PSAPs moves to the CAD map software.

Johnson asked for a motion to approve going into contract negotiations for a NG9-1-1 Consultant with L. R. Kimball. A motion was made by Lowery and seconded by Hicks. . A roll call vote was taken: Chairman King- Y, Hanson- Y, Hicks-Y, Jones- Y, Merritt- Y, Leverton- Y, and Lowery- Y. Motion passed.

Texting 911

 G. Johnson stated she is gathering documentation for education on texting to prepare for implementing and to address possible questions and concerns.

Legislation

- **9-1-1 Services Advisory Board** G. stated that with the HB2453 being passed that she may be asked to continue on the board.
- **HB2453** G. Johnson covered the documentation dealing with the approval of the legislation by the General Assembly. Johnson will pull together how this legislation will impact the ETSB wireless checks. Poison Control wording was pulled and they will be acquiring money from another area other than the wireless fund.

Participating Agency Request-

- **DeKalb Police Department** Lowery discussed a bill from Word System for the PSAP move October 2013. His concern was the hourly rate seemed a little high. Leverton stated he had sent the bill to G. Johnson to review. G. Johnson stated she will review and get back to the ETSB.
 - Feyerherm said he works on recorders on a regular basis and his hourly rate seemed to be a lower rate.
