Meeting started at 7:00 with Board President Jim Cox presiding and Herbert Holderman leading us in the pledge of allegiance.

Meeting Minutes:

Steve Walz made the motion that the minutes should be approved and it was seconded by Stefan Skopek. Motion passed unanimously.

Treasurers Report:

John Davis stated that the balance was still \$2,021.00 and 7 of the 16 veteran's organizations have paid their dues. Nothing changed from last month

For the Good of the Commission

Website – Steven Kreitzer explained that the office is trying to help out the local veterans' organizations to gain awareness and support by adding their contact information and events to our website. Forms were handed out at the meeting that explained how to submit information to the office to be placed on the website.

Superintendents Report:

Tammy Anderson reported that last month, the Commission helped 40 veterans with food, 32 with shelter, and 26 with utilities. There were 27 veterans transported in 23 trips to VA Hospitals. The Commission helped veterans collect \$11,560.42 in monthly benefits and \$74,331.74 in retroactive benefits. The monthly bills totaled \$41,568.58 and Jim Cox asked if there was a motion to pay the bills. Mike Boorsma made the motion to accept the superintendent's report and pay the bills and Stefan Skopek seconded. Randy Smith asked who would be participating in the training that was charged \$1,200 and Tammy Anderson explained that it would be all four full time employees. There was some more discussion on whether or not to close the office while the employees were gone at training and the consensus was to have it open if we could but no decision on who or if it would be open was decided on.

Committee Reports:

Frank Beierlotzer stated that the mayors memorial breakfast put on by the 40 et 8 is on Memorial Day and from 6:45-7:30. There will also be a motorcycle motorcade escort that day. Contact Frank at ffb66@juno.com for more information.

James Cox – President – explained that the executive committee has created new by-laws for the commission that they would like to present for a vote at the next meeting. The by-law proposals will be mailed out to each of the 16 veterans' organizations to let them know and ask for their attendance to vote.

Old Business

Doll House Progress – Tammy Anderson stated that the office had record of 85 tickets being sold already. Frank Beierlotzer then stated he had 30 more to turn in. It was explained that the office would take the money for the tickets and then turn the money over to John Davis, treasure, each month at the board meeting.

New Business

James Cox, president, stated that the employees would be gone at training for the June meeting and asked that the meeting be moved to June 2, 2014 instead with the same time and location. The general consensus was that this would be fine and therefore the meeting night was changed.
