Tammy Anderson also explained that those on assistance were re-applying so the office could get updated information to determine continued eligibility. Donald Jones made the motion to accept the report and pay the bills of \$29,867.57 Todd Latham seconded it. A roll call vote was taken and motion passed unanimously.
