a. Illinois Senate Bill 107 – Tammy Anderson explained that the bill would be the following if signed by the Governor as it has already passed both houses. "In a Section concerning the disabled veterans standard homestead exemption, provides that, for taxable years 2015 and thereafter: (i) if the veteran has a service connected disability of 30% or more but less than 50%, the annual exemption is \$2,500; (ii) if the veteran has a service connected disability of 50% or more but less than 70%, the annual exemption is \$5,000; and (iii) if the veteran has a service connected disability of 70% or more, then the property is exempt from taxation. Effective immediately." Some discussion ensued.
