The Commission helped Veterans collect \$526.46 in monthly benefits and \$65,315.00 in retroactive benefits. Tammy Anderson also reported that we need more volunteer drivers to transport veterans to the VA Hospitals. Donald Jones made the motion to accept the report and pay the bills of \$66,728.39 Randy Smith seconded it. A roll call vote was taken and motion passed unanimously.
