### **Treasurers Report:**

There is \$4,587.46 currently in the checking account. Mike Boorsma made the motion to accept the Treasurer's report subject to audit. Don Jones seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously. ### **Superintendent's Report:**

Tammy Anderson reported that last month, the Commission helped 17 Veterans and their families with shelter. There were 18 Veterans transported in 14 trips to VA Hospitals. The Commission helped Veterans collect \$12,108.00 in monthly benefits and \$474,950.00 in retroactive benefits. Mike Boorsma made the motion to accept the report and pay the bills of \$45,495.38 subject to audit, Donald Jones seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously by roll call of votes. Restricted Fund Balance of 2015 is \$619,300.79. Audit will be done.

### **Committee Reports:**

Frank Beierlotzer stated a Meet & Greet at the DeKalb County Rehab Wednesday January 11<sup>th</sup> at 9:30am all welcome. Dan Gallagher of American Legion post #66 DeKalb is having a Blood Drive Jan 21st, from 10:30am to 2pm, receive a \$10 Noodles & Company coupon if you donate pint of blood. Flyers will be available at the end of meeting and on the DCVAC website.

#### **Old Business:**

Steven Kreitzer reported that the meeting for The Wall That Heals went well. There is \$6,298.00 in the checking account. A minimum of \$4,000 is additionally needed. They are looking for ideas for fundraisers and to sell The Wall T-shirts, any help would be greatly appreciated. They still owe the other half of The Wall payment of \$3,750.00. Renee mentioned the website and every donor is listed on the website.

#### **New Business:**

Tammy Anderson spoke about Open Meetings Act (OMA) requirements and that every Delegate and Alternate needs to take the training once, and provide a copy of certificate to Luz to be kept on file. Discussion if board needs to do the Freedom of Information (FOIA), still undecided. The Illinois House Bill 4719 increases penalties on FOIA request's that are not handled properly. Luz is DCVAC's FOIA Officer and must do the training every year. The DCVAC office personnel are required to take the training yearly. Everyone can go online to the Illinois Attorney General's office and take the OMA training. Jim Cox made the suggestion to take the classes every year to stay informed of any changes.

Tammy Anderson mentioned that there has been a change to the Military Veterans Assistance Act (330 ILCS 45), The Delegate/Alternate Information Form needs to be completed yearly and returned to the DCVAC office within 30 days. This addition will be added to the by-laws after review of the DCVAC President & Superintendent.
